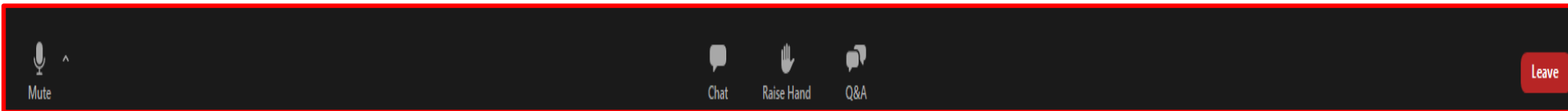

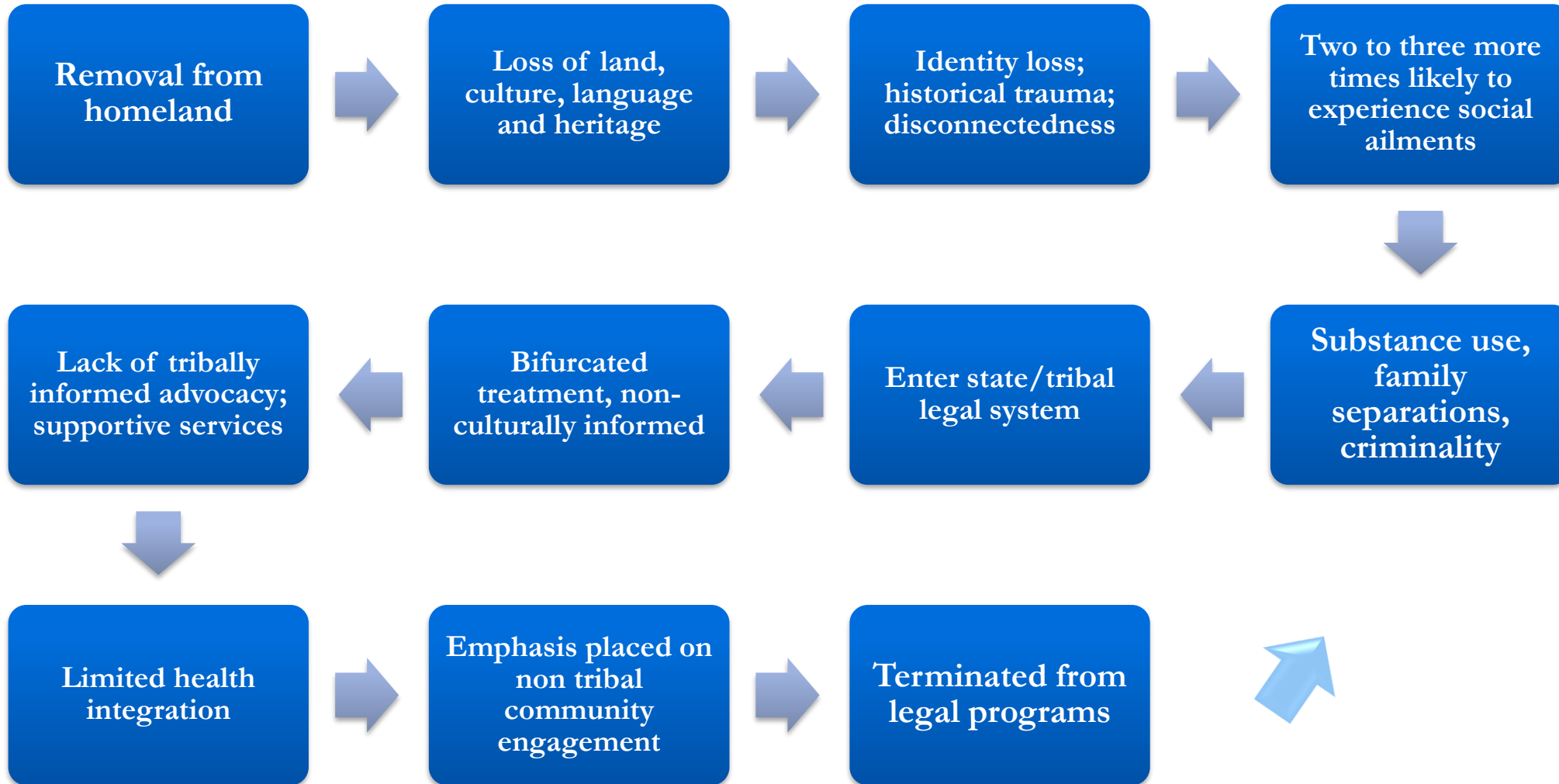


# Chickasaw Nation Governor

# The Vicious Cycle of Substance Use in Indian Country



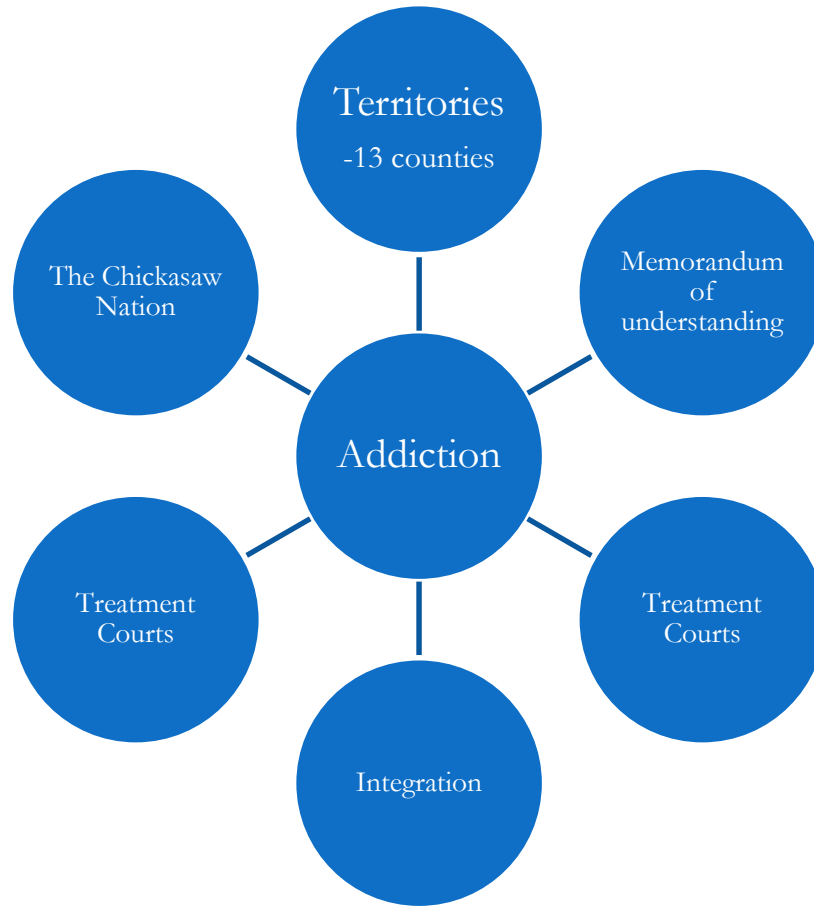

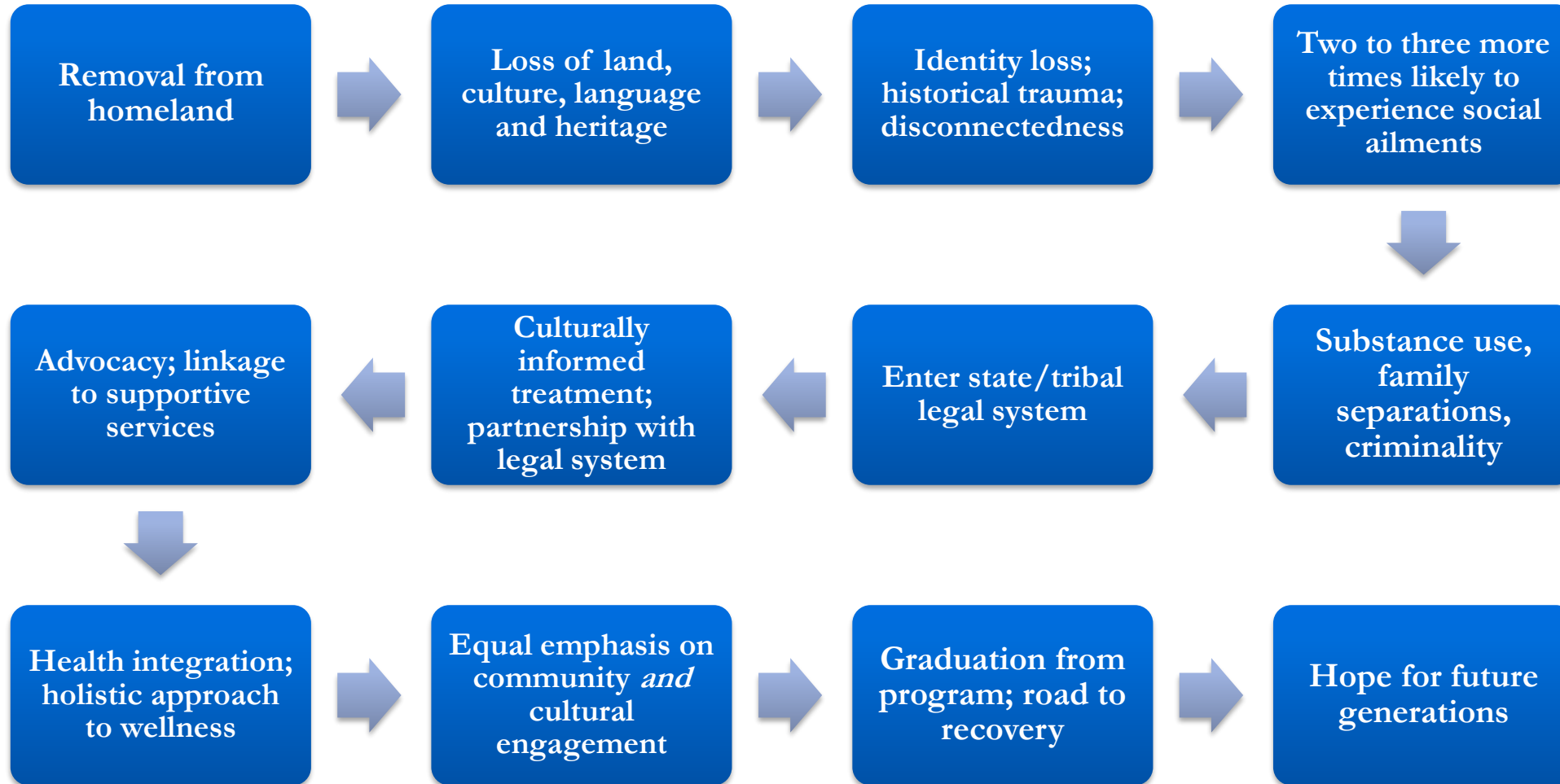
